Re: Budget Reallocation FY25

Date: May 10, 2024

The Board of Education's 2024-25 Operating Budget request was reduced by \$3,000,000 by the Board of Finance and was then passed through with no further reductions by the Board of Representatives. The resulting final budget of \$330,737,756 represents a 5.48% increase over the 2023-24 budget.

Below please find the Superintendent's proposed re-allocation, summarized by Major Object. This summary aligns with the presentation and discussion that took place at the Budget Workshop on Tuesday, May 7th:
